Mayor Edmondson welcomed attendees to visioning session and briefly discussed links to today's session and the municipality's strategic plan. He introduced Michael Barnier as the Facilitator for the session.

Council heard presentations and discussed the following:

- **Master Servicing Study Update**
Maureen Looby provided an update on the status of the master servicing study. Also, servicing issues within Arva, Delaware, Ilderton, Kilworth and Komoka were discussed.
- **Sanitary Sewage Allocation**
Andy Wright provided comments pertaining to the allocation of sewage treatment capacity.

- Roundabouts
Chris Traini presented a video on the use of roundabouts, and provided comments to the group on applicability of roundabouts within Middlesex Centre. Group discussion followed including comments pertaining to roundabouts, roadside grass maintenance along County Road Allowances and County requirements for road improvements for new development.
- Urban Design within the City of London
John Fleming and Sean Galloway provided a presentation on characteristics/parameters and principles of urban design within the City of London. The city's Urban Design Peer Review panel was discussed. Also discussed was the increased role of the Middlesex London District Health Unit in reviewing future development applications.
- Kilworth Komoka Secondary Plan
Marc Bancroft provided the group with a draft Terms of Reference for the Kilworth Komoka Secondary Plan and outlined the process the plan is expected to follow. Group discussion followed including comments on existing designated lands, down designating existing lands, economic development and the option of an interim control by-law until the secondary plan has been completed.
