## NOTICE DOG LICENCING INFORMATION

Middlesex Centre Dog Licences are issued from the Municipal Office located in Coldstream at 10227 Ilderton Rd. Please contact the Municipal Office in order to obtain a licence if you are new to Middlesex Centre or are a new dog owner.

Middlesex Centre Dog Licences are permanent. This means the licence tag you receive will be kept with your dog throughout their lifetime. There is a renewal fee each year for this licence. You will be receiving an invoice prior to the beginning of each year for the renewal fee. It is the responsibility of the owner to licence their dog and failure to licence is in contravention of the Animal Control By-law.

In order to obtain a new licence:

1. Complete the application (available online, or at our office)
2. Submit the form with payment (cheque, cash or debit) in person at the Municipal Office. Hours are Monday to Friday 8:30 a.m. to 4:30 p.m. **or**
3. Mail in the application with payment and a licence will be mailed to you.
