**5.1 2009 Pilot Program – Yard Waste Depots**

Maureen Looby gave a review that Council approved this pilot program and the template for evaluation. Mauro Castrilli gave an operational overview, noting that there were changes made to the sites through the season and that the operating dates for 2010 will be extended to the end of November in response to residents' comments. Greg LaForge reviewed the numerical information provided and noted that compost is available to Middlesex Centre residents at the two TRY sites. It was asked if there is a limit on the amount of compost allowed and also suggested that further notice of this product be provided to residents. It was requested that the 2010 data analysis would include a total cost per ton for each site. There was discussion regarding the financial information provided and staff noted that costs would be expected to decrease in the proposed second pilot year since the site changes have been done and resident comments are now more positive towards the sites. It was noted that staff will be further promoting the use of the two TRY sites.
