IMPORTANT NOTICE LEAD SAMPLING PROGRAM VOLUNTEERS

As part of the ongoing efforts to ensure the safety of drinking water in Ontario, the Ministry of Environment and Climate Change under Regulation 170/03 requires community wide testing for lead in municipal drinking water systems within the Middlesex Centre Distribution System. This includes residents who receive municipal water in Arva, Ballymote, Birr, Denfield, Delaware, Ilderton, Melrose, Kilworth and Komoka.

The Municipality of Middlesex Centre is seeking volunteers for Sampling Points in Plumbing that Serves Private Residences who would permit staff of our licensed Operators to access to their home for lead testing between the hours of 8 am and 3 pm. The lead testing in private residences will take place at a point where water is used for human consumption (ie. kitchen tap). It is anticipated that each test will take approximately 45 minutes and to use less than 50 litres of water.

All volunteers will be given ample notice prior to the sampling and occupants will receive a copy of the test results.
