The information provided in this financial dashboard is built from the Municipality's audited Financial Statements and Financial Information Return.

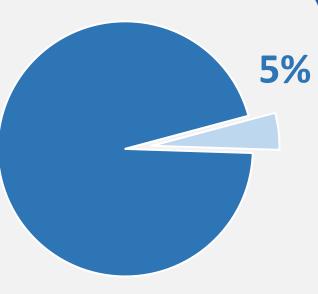


Tax receivables compared to taxes levied

- Indicates low collectability issues for the municipality



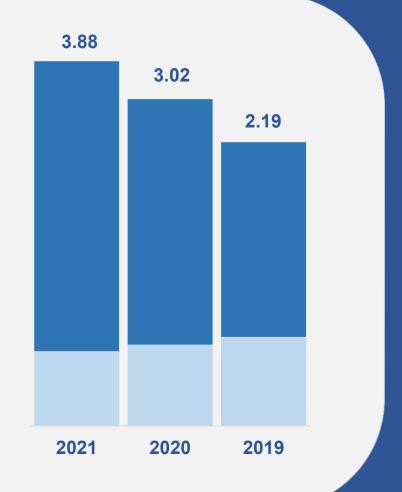


Debt Service Coverage Ratio

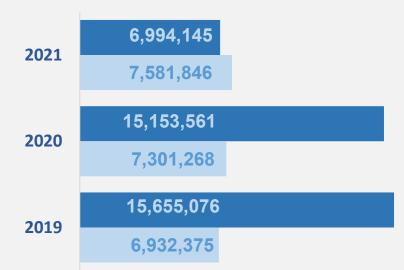


Asset Sustainability Ratio

- Deferred capital projects



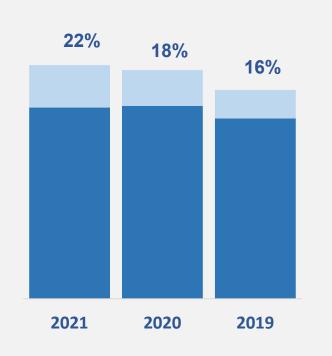


Operating Surplus Ratio
